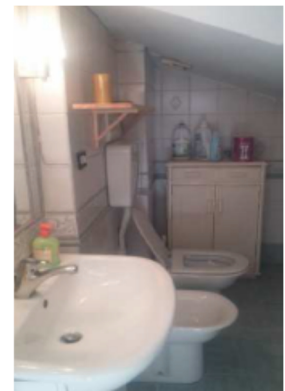
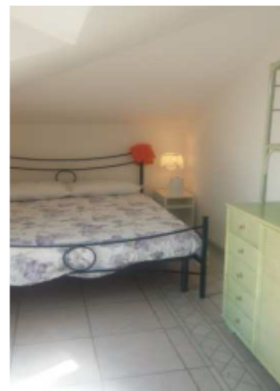
Accommodation:

Located in a quiet and well-served area of the city, on the top floor of a stately building, the penthouse is composed of:

- *- Dining room and large living room (with a double bed sofa) and TV*
- *- Fully equipped kitchen*
- *- 1 Double room*
- *- Bathroom with shower and washing machine*
- *- Terrace of 140 mtq.

From its large balcony guests will be amazed with breathtaking views: from the Euganean Hills to the Domes of the most important basilicas of the city.



The apartment is situated in the southern area of the city and it is easily reachable from the ring road for those coming from Milan or from northern Europe, and from the highway for those coming from Bologna. It is well served by public transportation (about 7 km from the city's Railway Station; about 500 mt from the bus stop, from a walking distance to the tram station).

PARTICULARS:

- *- Daily Price per person € 30.00, for children under 10 years old, 50% discount *;
- *- For 1 or 2 nights stay, additional cost of € 35.00 for the cleaning and services (water, electricity, gas and laundry)*;

The city of Padua is rich in sights of interest: cultural (museums, universities, the large old town), religious (monasteries, churches and the famous Basilica del Santo), tourism (the thermal baths of Abano and Montegrotto, the Euganean Hills with its small medieval villages like Arquà Petrarca and Montagnana which are only a few kilometers away, and finally, the sea and the pre-Alpine mountain).

The city also lies in the heart of the Veneto Region and it is placed in a strategic position to visit famous cities such as Venice (30km), Verona (60 km) and Treviso (40 km).
